### SILENCE IMAGINATION

"Imagine yourself at the North pole. Try not to think of a white bear."

Sometimes unrestrained, the open world of imagination tends to delineate our intricate mind. Consider the above-prescribed thought experiment. Some will fail to comply or suppress the image of the white bear as instructed above as the more one tries, the more the image surfaces. This thought process is a direct example suggesting how ungovernable can imagination be. Indeed because of its involuntary and by some means, subconscious nature, we tend to be unaware of its function in almost every day in our lives. It is so banal to a point it merges into our reality. You might think imagination requires skill and only applicable for certain circumstances, but it is not a separate quality that can switch on and off occasionally. It is a basic trait of human being, also an essential problem-solving tool which function is to envision the process of ideas, events, objects, or situations without the presence of the senses.

The above paragraph might only describe one of many definitions of imagination, considering the broad and extensive studies of its taxonomy that had been carried out. Nevertheless, as commonly assumed in short, imagination is regarded as the process of conceiving creations. Hence this idea is always entwined with the 'counterpart' of creations, the artists. Imagination epitomized the raison d'être of the artists, a trait that defines them. Although this is partly true (as it does not only apply to artists), artists' creations are always born from this mere and lawless boundary of imagination. The canvas is literally their mindscape, a 'world' to simulate their wandering mind, which only the limit is the frame.

Consequently, what makes artists imagining or visualizing what they choose to visualize? As imagination tends to be so arbitrary without any driven force, what sort of force or direction that gives impetus to the imagination to be manifested as desired? How can imagination be deemed to be 'silenced' or contained by this agency/agencies? On that matter, SILENCE IMAGINATION denotes how the artists cope with the imagination as far as identity and art practice are two imperative aspects of their art making.

### THE CUP OF TEA

Pertain to the thematic content of this exhibition imagination, I came up with two possible aspects that shaped the imagination of these artists as mentioned previously; identity and the art practice. Imagination needs a vehicle or a 'vessel' to be contained. This 'vessel' is the aspect that holds shape to the imagination. It's like pouring water into a cup, only the cup is different, given the differences of its form. Let's say the cup is the artist's identity. A different form of cup represents one's different identity. As an artist, one could not run away from the fact that identity contributes significantly to articulating one's story in an artwork. Identity is undoubtedly the 'vessel' or the cup, designed by individuals' circumstances be it from the personal level or of societal milieu. It is the identity that channels and gives substance to imagination to become meaningful.

Nonetheless, imagination could also be conjured when there's action and that is why art practice is substantially important. Art practice will always propel interconnection between reality (the handling) and imagination that determine how artists presenting their ideas. As an aesthetic-driven individual, artists will always be attached to this urge of experimenting be it with mediums, materials or the visual itself. Experimenting notes their freedom of exploring imagination henceforth opens up possibilities towards an astonishing outcome while still retaining identity. It is by these hands-on, tryand-error experiences that an artist could really test the water. They are the only one who knows what suits their 'cup of tea', what sort of taste that they are looking for, while still acknowledging a room for improvement.

### THE ARTISTS

Aiman Aisamuddin and Tiffany Lafuente's works articulate the relationship between the real and the imaginary space. Aiman incorporates and visualizes his own self into the semi-abstract constructed space that connotes his inexplicable self-monologues, while the use of expressive colors and signs insinuate his enthusiasm in invoking affective mood from the viewer. Tiffany, on the other hand, brings us a provocative rendition of imagery. The seemingly satirical signs along with casual plop of colours and lines composed in a setting give us the sense of interjection to reality, perhaps alluding mockery toward the things she experiences in real life.

Azam Aris and Dexter Sy shared some similarities in having satirical elements in their works. Their works at some point undertake commentary position concerning the perception of nowadays' society who seemed to fall into generalizing identity. Taking back elements from the past and incorporates them with nowadays pop culture—especially in the music world—both Azam and Dexter portray their respective identity with wittiness, ironic yet very much critical to ponder upon. Azam's repetition of subject nuances his critical observation on globalization and mass culture that take place in this modern era. Meanwhile, for Dexter, his keen interest in the collision of cultures is emphasized in his usage of multicultural symbolism throughout his paintings. Past experience is a valuable insignia of the mind as it entails emotional attachment to it. Sharing it with others takes a deliberate attempt considering how one should express the indescribable emotions.

Chok Yue Zan and Ming Hao at some level share the same degree of conveying this inevitable juncture of their lives—though they take a different kind of approach. Both romanticize their stage of lives beautifully where we can see the use of nature elements as metaphors of Chok Yue Zan's works convey this sense of temporality, while Ming Hao's paint-skins peeling technique exquisitely reveals and capture the intensity of emotions throughout his works.

Last but not least, *Poodien* and *Yogie Achmad Ginanjar* take on the issue of the relationship between the existing structured power and society. Poodien is much known for his interdisciplinary practice as

different takes on societal issues take different shapes of discipline, accord with his intended message that he tries to assert. Sometimes radical in approach, his works expect to challenge the viewer's fundamental truth, to regurgitate one's point of view about their position as a society and their worldview in general. Meanwhile to Yogie, his keen interpretations on western ideologies and fallacies of the westerneastern perspective very much have shaped his process of art making. In particular, his interest in the theory of power/order versus chaos can be seen in his approach of harmonizing abstraction with representational elements in his works.

#### CONCLUSION

Indeed, imagination tends to be groundless without any driven force. As an artist, one's art making is always ascribes to an intention, therefore imagination becomes relational depending on the aspects that give shape to it. From my point of view, pertain to this exhibition, two aspects such as identity and art practice are seen to have immense influence towards these artists in articulating what they chose to visualize.

Identity contained imagination to be shaped according to one's intention, which ultimately gives meaning to that imagination. Meanwhile, art practice becomes a factor that encouraged an artist to be experimental, to put imagination at test. Art practice determines the approach and subjects that suit them best, while identity is being retained. It is no doubt a challenge to find an intersection between delivering the intended message while still being very imaginative at the same time. By all means, this exhibition happens to act as a justification for these artists in endeavouring the challenge and succeed in their own terms.






The Freedom
