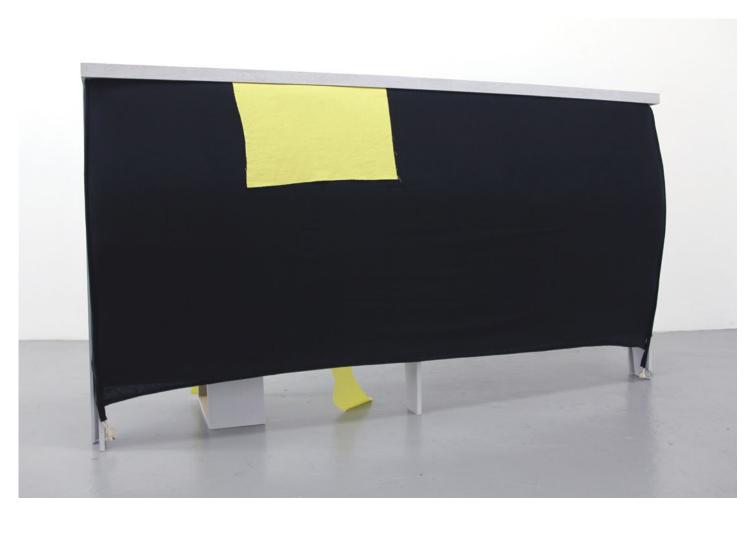

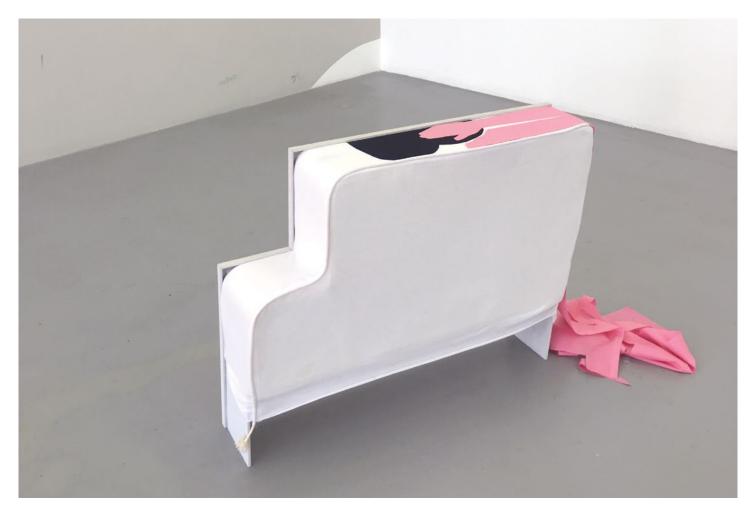

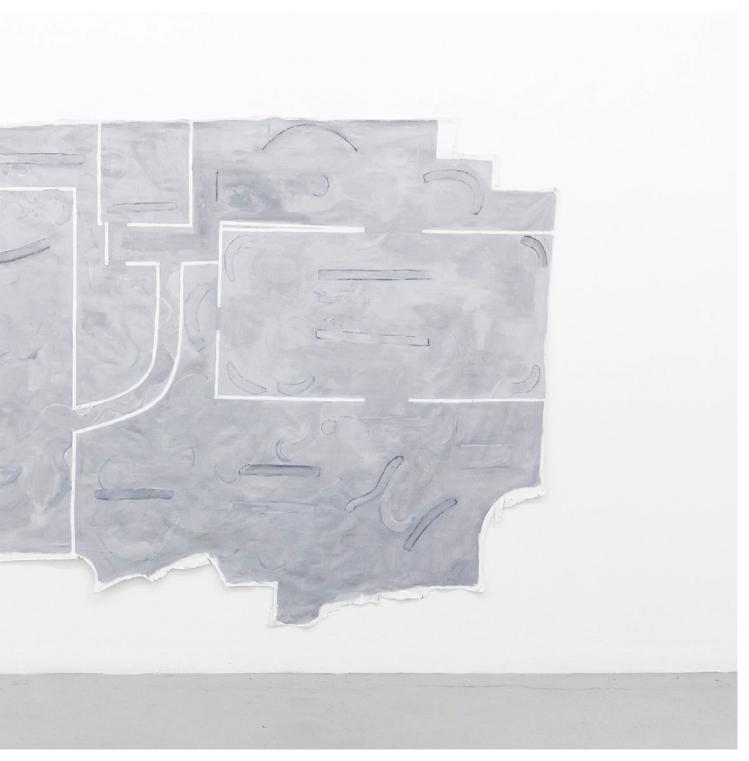

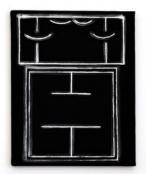


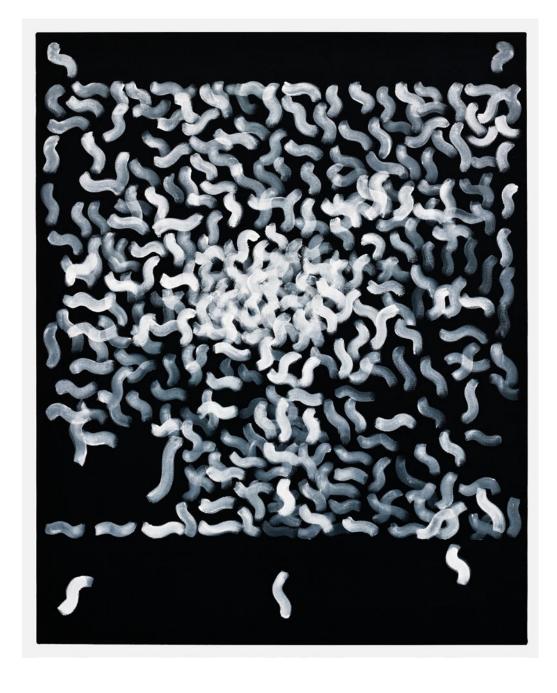

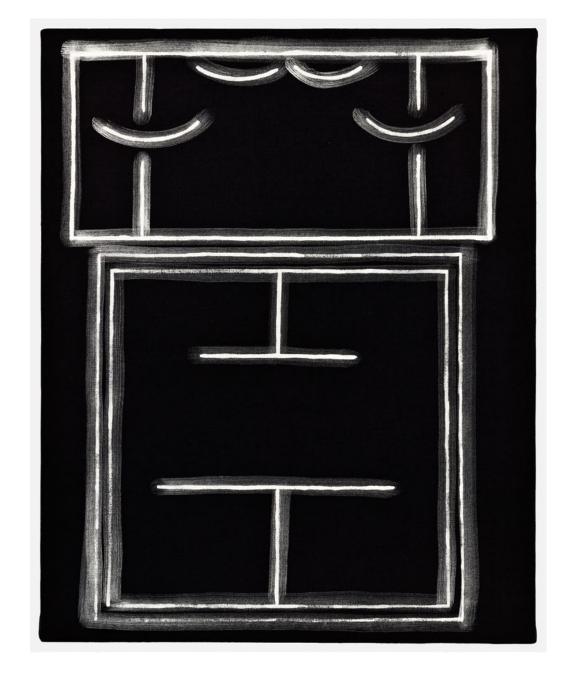


Situation Room (white), 2013 Acrylic on fabric; 155 x 120 cm

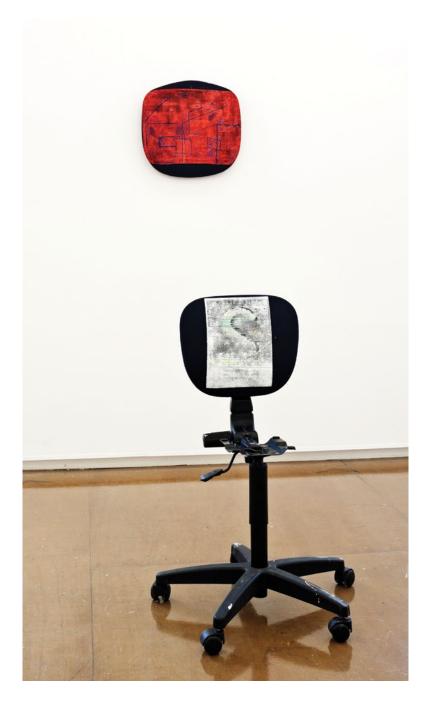

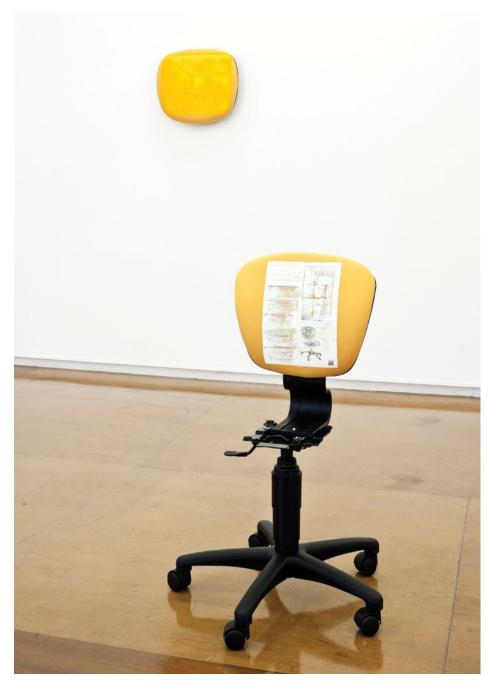


Two thirds of function (CEO Swivel), 2013 Acrylic on office chair; $124 \times 70 \times 70$ cm

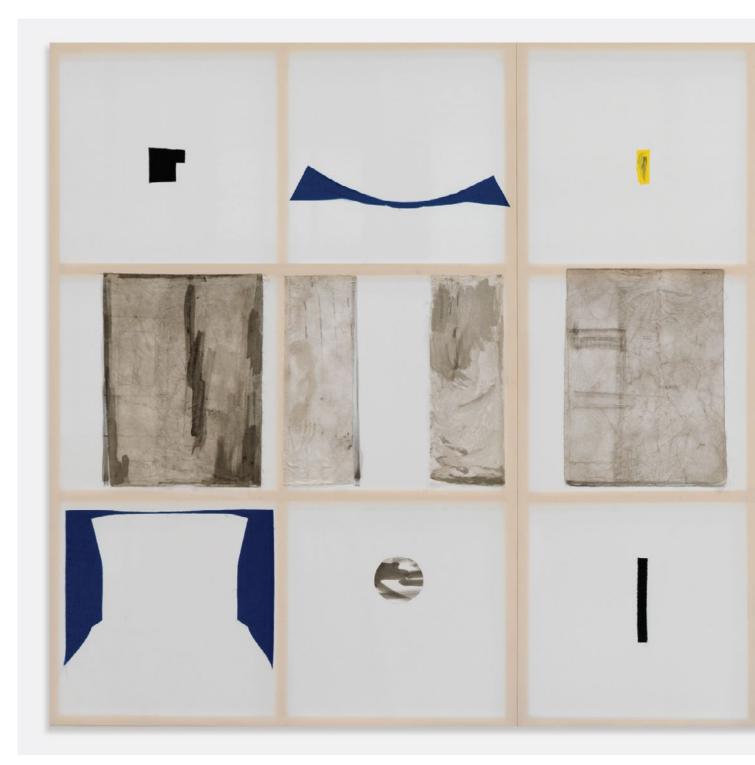

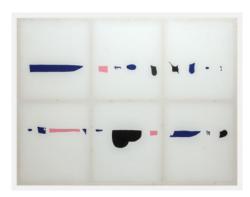






COVER THE WORLD TO REVEAL IT

She works, in fact, like a stage director: Gerda Scheepers brings her different works to life by bestowing upon them their own internal narrative, like characters in a play. Each of them is cast a role; each work interacts with its surroundings while remaining an autonomous body. Titles are often borrowed from other structural environments in society, their inherent structures imitated and modified, a blend of the representational and abstract that they share with the works they designate. Painting, object, and space participate in a story that is abstract, written with method and material. Scheepers does not hierarchise the animate and the inanimate worlds, rather she applies the same work method to both: merging them into a layer with which to cover.

One particular material plays a predominant role in this gesture: the fabric. It has transformative abilities - by being a flexible and malleable material, by being able to take on shape and colour, by adapting to any surface and volume. In her work, Scheepers uses fabric to the full extent of its capacities. She pulls it out on canvas stretchers, revealing its structure and allowing intimate details to appear. She makes objects seeminaly wear clothes; she covers furniture objects as if with a protective second skin. When she applies paint to a wall, it is also to evoke textile qualities [see pages 26-29: Wall Stretch (Amazon Mist) and Wall Stretch (Ocean Mist). Seemingly attached to fixing points located in the corners of the wall, the "stretched out" paint becomes fabric, creating the illusion of a cover hiding the nakedness of the wall with its opacity. A certain eroticism pervades from the evocative shapes produced, and the play between the hidden/unveiled. Here, the fabric embodies its role of covering: it fits itself around the shapes, follows the contours, and so reveals abstract "bodies".

Through the medium of collage, Scheepers uses fabric to represent or imitate forms and familiarities. In Showing method, showing message (2016), the arrangement of fabric offcuts in straight lines across the plane is reminiscent of a sentence, written in a new language unit and telling us a mysterious message. The fabric may furthermore take the form of human bodies, or, to be exact, their shadows. Maneuverable and soft, these shadows are draped on or between the furniture, sometimes half obscured. The fabric here imitates both physical and psychological gestures; attitudes like tiredness and breakdown; expressions of sensations; like material 'actors' in a narrative.

Whether it be a sculpture, painting, drawing or even video - such as *Studio Ballet* (2009) - in which body, gestures, paintings and voices are superimposed and blend into each other to form a single layer, Scheepers approaches all the different artistic mediums in the same way. It is in fact through this merging of motif, method and gesture that she moves away from dualisms such as form and content, figuration and abstraction, and two- and three-dimensionality.

Scheepers wrote in 2013 of her "group of works in between painting and sculpture, with slightly dishonest ambitions towards the performing arts, and active jealousy of the written or spoken". She continues to follow their declared precarious ambitions, ultimately revealing the performative aspect in all of her works, through a material narration.

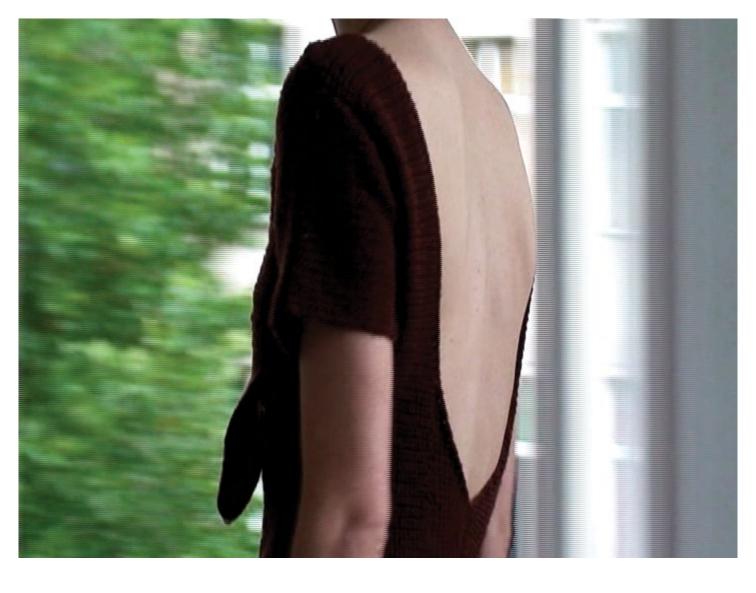
