
Light_Wait features new work by Biljana Jancic and Bonita Bub. The works reorganise the space in MOP gallery to create a scene or a stage, which offers a sense of anticipation for an event fated not to be. Visitors are encouraged to wait for something to unfold however they are not rewarded with a spectacle but rather met with a disclosure of the mechanisms operating behind the codified gallery environment.

Jancic's floor to ceiling plastic tubes combined with Bub's elongated, modular objects appropriate the dramatic device of the intermission or pause to build the anticipation for the upcoming crux. This moment of inaction allows for an opportunity to be present within the particular moment and invites the audience to slow down. In this case, just be with the indeterminate, in-between or possibly even the mundane aspects of the present.

In a society obsessed with speed, movement and a fear of falling behind, the pause is a critical strategy to explore in contemporary art. In Light_Wait, it manifests in a range of cues: from monochromatic surfaces to the illumination of gaps and voids. Also, in this post-enlightenment landscape where only the commodity is steeped in light, it is important to enlighten instances of indeterminate emptiness, without the comfort of distraction or escapism.
